

RULES OF ENTRY

Cancellation and changes

- All entry fees are used for staging the event and are non-refundable.
- We reserve the right to alter or reduce any route course. We will try to notify participants in advance of any significant changes before the event; however, this may not always be possible.

General terms of entry

- All participants and supporters must abide by the instructions or regulations displayed or given on the day of the Event by police and/or Event officials.
- The organisers take no responsibility for the loss or damage of participants' property and walkers should have their own insurance in place for any injury suffered or loss or damage of personal property.
- Walkers must always obey the Highway Code and Country Code
- All walkers under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a responsible adult.
- If you are registering a participant who is under 18, you must have permission from that person's parent or legal guardian.
- Please note that it is crucial that you arrive within the correct time slot for your distance. You will not be able to begin your event in the incorrect time slot.
- First aid facilities will be provided at the International Waendel Walk; however, you are responsible for your own health and safety whilst taking part.
- By registering to take part in the International Waendel Walk you are confirming that you are fully aware of any potential risks to yourself and any others involved.
- Please do not attempt the longer routes unless you are used to walking your chosen distance.
- Participants are responsible for ensuring that they are sufficiently fit and healthy to take part in the event and are not participating against the advice of the medical profession.
- Any participant unsure of their physical ability to take part must seek medical advice from their General Practitioner prior to the Event.
- If you experience any difficulties whilst on the route or feel unwell, please ring the emergency mobile numbers on your wristband and make sure you give clear instructions of your location to enable our emergency team to find you.
- We reserve the right to refuse entry to the event, if for whatever reason we consider a person unfit to take part.
- Wheelchair and mobility scooter users are encouraged to enter providing they have assistance at the Event. Please check that your proposed route is wheelchair accessible on our [website](#) before completing your registration.
- We want you to have an enjoyable day so please be prepared for all weathers and make sure you have plenty of water with you to avoid dehydration, suitable footwear and clothing for walking and a mobile phone with you in case of emergency.
- Control points and toilets are available at regular intervals on routes where refreshments may be purchased.
- We respectfully ask all participants along with their supporters to be respectful of residents whilst out on the route and not to make any excessive noise.
- We respectfully ask all participants and their supporters do not drop litter but carry it with you until you can dispose of it responsibly. There are litter and recycling facilities available within the venues and around the course.

Event closure

- The Finish Desk will close at 21:00 on Friday and 5:30pm on Saturday and Sunday.
- We reserve the right to shut down the Event course and close access to our finish venue after an appropriate amount of time has passed from the start of the Event.
- Any participant who has not finished the Event by this time but chooses to continue does so at their own risk with the understanding that they are no longer considered a participant of the Event, and as such are not eligible for any Event resources (including but not limited to pit stops, suppliers, venues, refreshments, course direction/support, personnel etc), and that they absolve us of any and all responsibility and progress entirely at their own risk.

Data protection (GDPR)

- All personal data held by us will be handled in accordance with applicable privacy laws.
- By providing your information when you register for the International Waendel Walk, we will use it for the purposes of organising, staging, and administering the Event.
- If you provide personal information on behalf of additional entrants, please only provide this if they have confirmed that they are happy for you to do so as we will use this information for the same purposes.
- If you are treated by medical providers, your details may be passed on to us only for health and safety purposes and to fulfil our legal obligations.
- Please note that we and our authorised service providers and agents or commercial partners may film or photograph participants, volunteers and spectators taking part or attending the Event and use such footage or photographs for the following reasons:
 - To publicise the Event for commercial and/or fundraising purposes including, but not limited to, social media, television broadcasts, advertising, publications, marketing material, merchandising, and other documents that may be made available to the public.
 - Or for our commercial partners to publicise their involvement and/or association with the Event.
- Subject to the above, please only register a participant under the age of 18 if the participant's parent/legal guardian are happy for their images to be used in the manner described.
- If you do not wish to have your photograph taken or for your photos to be made available as described above, please tell the photographer on the day.
